

## **LUNG CANCER SCREENING & PREVENTION ACT**

"Research has shown that access to regular screenings can save lives by detecting cancer earlier, and new, innovative tests can mean more cancers are detected early in more people," said *Lisa Lacasse, president of the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network (ACS CAN)*. "ACS CAN supports the passage of the bipartisan Lung Cancer Screening and Prevention Act to provide a pathway for Medicare coverage of new and innovative lung cancer screening tests."
