The deadline to submit artwork is 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 21. Students will need to submit their art competition form online and the entries should be mailed or delivered to one of my District office locations.

The entries will be judged by an independent selection committee. The winning entry will be displayed for one year in the United States Capitol alongside artwork from every congressional district across the country.

The piece that receives the highest number of likes and shares combined will be named the Facebook Fan Favorite! The winner's art piece will hang in my Washington, DC office for one year.
